**Overview of new initiatives:** Programs are continuing to revise and rewrite curriculum and deliver the newly established Rhode Island Career and technical Education (CTE) standards.

### **General state of ag ed in your state:**

In the state of Rhode Island we have five agriculture education programs. Four of those programs have FFA chapters. In the last few years four out of five of the programs were approved to be Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs. This means students from across the state now have access to attend a school with an agriculture program. All tuition is paid for by their sending school district. This opportunity has opened a door to a larger number of students. In addition the schools and FFA Chapters have gained opportunity with access to these students.
